FOREVER YOUNG: 30 Years of the Heide Collection The Revolutionary Years: 1940s

The 1940s were a watershed in the development of modern art in Melbourne, and throughout the decade Heide was a hub for avant-garde artists and writers. It was a spirited and ambitious period of cultural achievement that has since become central to the history and trajectory of Australian art. John and Sunday Reed were catalysts, not only art collectors but also benefactors and tireless promoters of experimental creative expression, leading the way in the formation of a home-grown Australian modernism.

In these years the Reeds helped launch the careers of artists now considered major figures—Arthur Boyd, Joy Hester, Sidney Nolan, John Perceval, Albert Tucker and Danila Vassilieff—today collectively known as the Angry Penguins, after the progressive journal published by the Reeds and Max Harris. Their various preoccupations and innovations can be seen in this section of 'Forever Young', including one of Nolan's earliest images of Ned Kelly's black mask, preceding his iconic series painted at Heide from 1946 to 1947; two of Tucker's landmark Images of Modern Evil; a range of Hester's compelling psycho-portraits; and several of the surrealistexpressionist allegories that established Boyd's artistic reputation.

The spectre of war cast its long shadow over much of the decade, and many of the works exhibited evoke these artists' responses to the unsettled social and political climate. The personal experience of war prompted a marked shift in their work from an objective to subjective reality. Boyd's hallucinatory visions of human suffering such as *The Kite*, Tucker's *Children of Athens* and Hester's *Victim by Fence* each make a stark statement about the horrors perpetrated by humanity against its own kind.

Nolan's war saw him stationed in the Wimmera district in north-western Victoria, where he brought a fresh perspective to the representation of the Australian landscape, as evidenced by *Wimmera Landscape* and *Dimboola*. The personal relationship he and the other artists had with both John and Sunday Reed are reflected in the paintings shown here. As well as Nolan's homages to Sunday, his lover, there are works by Vassilieff, who died at Heide in John Reed's arms; Joy Hester's surrealist drawing of Sunday's doll, Gethsemane; and a range of early images by John Perceval which the Reeds acquired when he was completely unknown as an artist.
